A I was in Dutch Guiana from the latter part of January or the early part of February, 1916, until December of that year, with the exception of about six weeks when I returned to the States. I think I left in August to return again the first part of October.

THE EXAMINER: And you were entirely in the employ of this company?

THE WITNESS: Yes, during that period.

THE EXAMINER: Bring him down now to exactly what you want to prove in this case.
