

MR. WHITELEY: That you visited in connection with this exploration work?

A There are two general deposits of bauxite in Dutch Guiana; one on the Suriname River, and Power Creek, another one is the Cottica River, near the headwaters of the Cottica River.

Q Did you visit both localities or territories?

A I visited both localities. I also visited a number of other rivers where bauxite was supposed to be found, but where we did not find it.

Q Now, will you state for the record where the known bauxite deposits of British Guiana are located, which you visited or explored for the Demerara Bauxite Company?

A The principal known deposits in British Guiana are located on the Demerara River, ^{starting} about 63 from its mouth and extending up the river for about 15 miles, including both banks of the river. There is another deposit field or group of deposits located on the Berbice River.

Q Did you explore and examine all of these deposits?

A A majority of the deposits on both rivers.

Q Now, continue, if you please, Mr. Emery, and state what you did next after your trip to Venezuela for the Uihlein Group in December and January of 1919; how long did that particular work last?
