MR. SMITH: Just a minute. I would like to have a chance to interrogate this witness before he answers that question.

THE EXAMINER: Go on.

BY MR. SMITH:

Q What was the name of this office, Mr. Emery? The one in British Guiana?

A It is the office of the Commissioner of Lands and Mines.

Q And you claim that you saw some maps in the office, did you?

A I said I saw a tracing.

Q In that office?

A Yes, sir.

Q You don't know of your own knowledge who made that tracing, do you? You didn't see it made?

A I don't know.

MR. SMITH: Now we object to any evidence concerning that map, at present, because the witness has said he does not know who made it.

BY MR. WHITELEY:

Q Was there anything on that map or tracing showing by whom it was made?
