

(The witness examines Commission's Exhibit No. 799)

A There are two tracts here in yellow which represent Christianburg and Wismar.

BY MR. WHITELEY:

Q These were the two you speak of now?

A Wismar had been acquired by the Demerara Bauxite Company and part of Christianburg, and we were negotiating for the part of Christianburg that remained.

Q Now after this visit to British Guiana in the spring of 1924, I believe you stated you made another trip there later on during that year?

A I left for British Guiana shortly after the first of November, the same year, 1924.

Q Will you tell us why you made that trip, Mr. Emery?

A There were two reasons for making that trip. One was to examine the property in Dutch Guiana that Uihlein's had acquired an option on and the other was to settle the question of the boundary to Aurora and Semarie, in Lower Semarie.

Q Will you tell us just what property/^{the}Uihlein's had secured an option on prior to this trip?

✓ A There was a group of properties, the major part of which was known as Accreabo or Carreabo.

Q Can you tell us approximately the acreage of these deposits?

A I don't remember the acreage, it was my impression about 1000 acres.
