

Q You made an analysis of some of this, did you?

A I had a number of samples analyzed. I don't remember just how many, but it was certainly over a dozen.

THE EXAMINER: Broadly speaking that is about 2500 acres in all?

THE WITNESS: Yes, that is if you consider the two properties.

THE EXAMINER: That is what I am speaking of. The two instances that you have spoken of, the two, - 1,000 acres and 500 acres.

THE WITNESS: Two tracts which were practically 1,000 acres and one tract of 500 acres.

THE EXAMINER: Exactly. All right.

BY MR. WHITELEY:

Q Does that take into consideration the Christianburg deposits now?

A The Christianburg deposit was a very small acreage, but very high value. My recollection was around 30 acres.

Q How does the South American bauxite that is in British and Dutch Guiana compare in quality with regard to its alumina content, with the American bauxite deposits, and deposits within the United States which you have knowledge of, Mr. Emery?

A I should say the British Guiana was much clearer than any ore which we have now in the United States in quality.
