

SPECIAL NOTICE

To Junior Members of the
American Society for Testing Materials:

Some misunderstanding having arisen as to the terms on which Junior Members of the American Society may acquire the Proceedings of the recent Sixth Congress of the International Association, the following announcement is made.

The Proceedings of the Congress will be published in two parts of about 1,100 pages each, which are expected to be available about three months from date.

Junior Members of the American Society holding membership also in the International Association, may exercise one of the following options:

(a) to receive these Proceedings, without extra charge, in the form in which they will be distributed by the International Association.

(b) to receive these Proceedings bound in conformity with the binding of the Proceedings of the American Society at the following added charges for binding and postage:

Cloth binding at 50 cents per volume \$1.00
Half-leather binding at \$1.00 per volume \$2.00

Junior Members of the American Society not holding membership in the International Association are entitled to these Proceedings in cloth binding at an extra payment of \$2.50, or, if half-leather binding is desired, at an extra payment of \$3.50.

In a previous announcement it was stated that orders for these Proceedings from Junior Members would be received up to April 1st. It has since been found necessary to place the limiting date at March 1st, and no responsibility can be assumed for orders not received prior to that date.

Junior Members desiring to acquire these Proceedings are requested to communicate promptly with the undersigned. All orders must be accompanied by the appropriate remittance.
