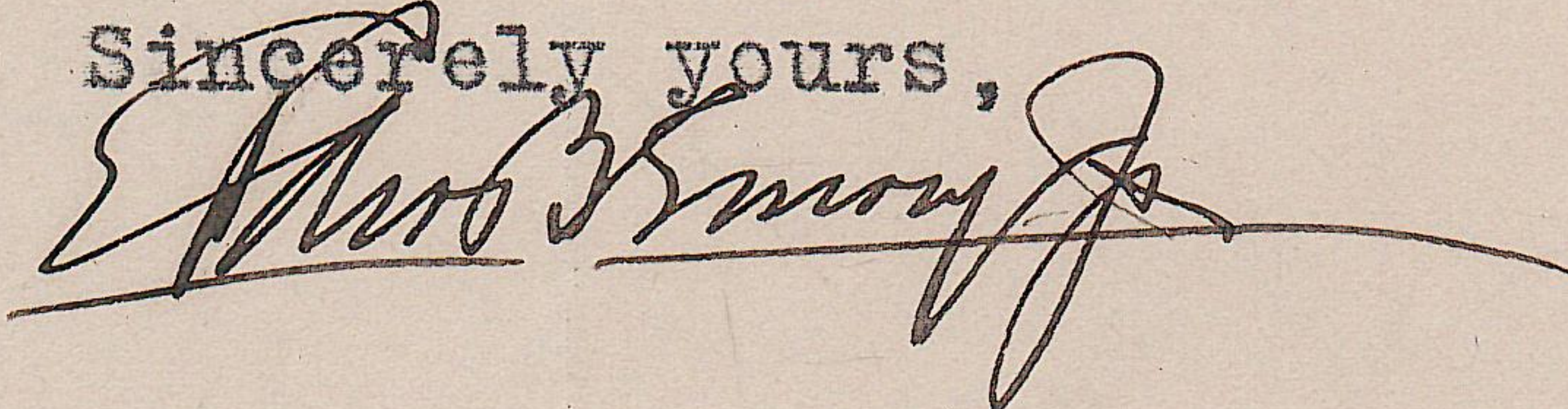
Dear Lloyd:
