

SUGGESTIONS AS TO CLOTHING.

---

Owing to the time of year, the locality in which the party is to operate and conditions to be met, it is suggested that each man have in his outfit the following list of articles or their equivalent:

- 2 pr. of lace leather boots
- 1 " " house shoes
- 1 reefer or Mackinaw jacket
- 1 rain coat or "slicker"
- 1 sweater
- gloves suitable to owner's work
- 2 Pr. Kahki or corduroy pants
- plenty of heavy socks and heavy underclothing
- 1 cap with ear covers
- 1 pr. blankets
- If you have it, 1 "Gold Medal" camp cot.
- Soft collars or blue flannel shirts are preferable to starched collars.

A heavy piece of canvas and straps should be provided with which to "do up" the blankets. The boots can be packed in the same bundle.

Baggage will be limited to two suit cases and blanket roll per man. If trunks are taken they will have to be stored at the starting point or forwarded at the owner's expense.
