

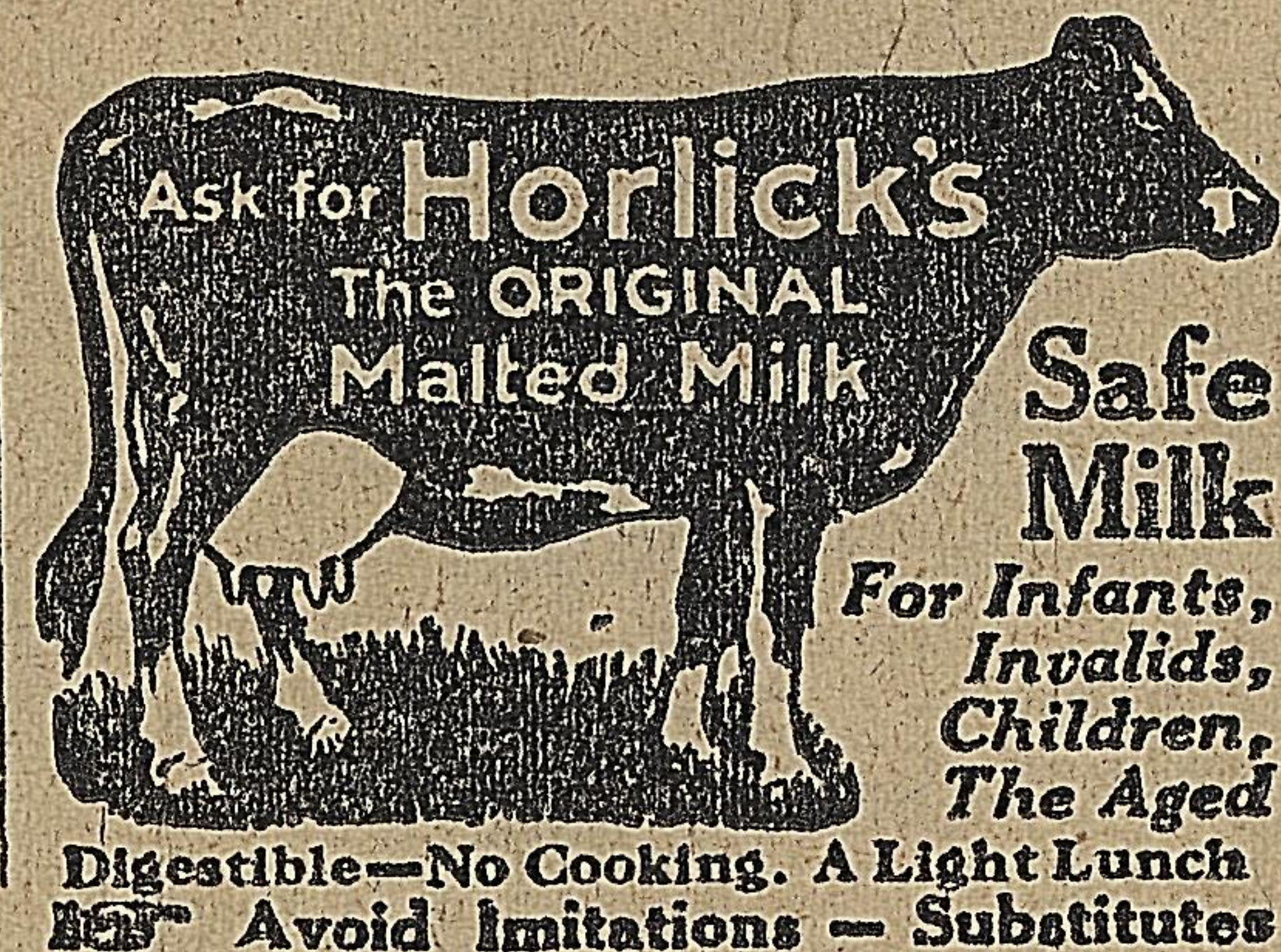

SCENTS PLOT IN DINES CASE

Judge Thinks Witnesses Have Sup-
pressed Evidence

Los Angeles, Jan. 22.—(By A. P.)—
That there "appears to be a conspir-
acy" to suppress evidence in the hear-
ing of Horace A. Greer, chauffeur for
Mabel Normand, film actress, charged
with shooting Courtland S. Dines, was
the statement made from the bench to-
day by Judge Hanby, hearing the case.
Judge Hanby said:
'I am not at all satisfied with the

testimony that has been given in this
