back ground along the outside by the
Stall doors - as it is hardly ever frozen
there - the weeds can only be pulled
out of the blackberry and brambles
patches when the ground is thawed and
when done the manure should be put
on a sizer as promptly - and before
Dunn's hauls out the back ground; the
pig pen manure, he can haul
out on the corn tillage because it
is not so good for the garden as the ma-
nure I have directed you to haul out,
the cots in the hog pen manure making
the ground bad to use.
