The bearer of this note will bring back my two mares and two colts now at your place unless you are willing on account of my liberal patronage to breed the pacing mare back to Happy Russell after she foals for one hundred dollars good for season of 1892, with return privileges until July 1st, 1893 in which case he will load at this time only the one eyed mare and two colts.

Of course if you prefer on account of your other customers to breed Almonta, the mare just received, for fifty dollars in consideration of the lateness of the season and my having already bred four times to your horse and then enter the pacing mare to be bred again after she foals for one hundred and fifty dollars it will be all the same to me. Considering my present stock of brood mares I feel I should not pay over one hundred dollars service fee for them, but I expect in a year or two to have fillies deep enough in the blood to breed to the very best horses.

I have no intention at present of going out of the business and if you decide to accept above proposition to retain the pacing mare I trust you may not lose anything.
