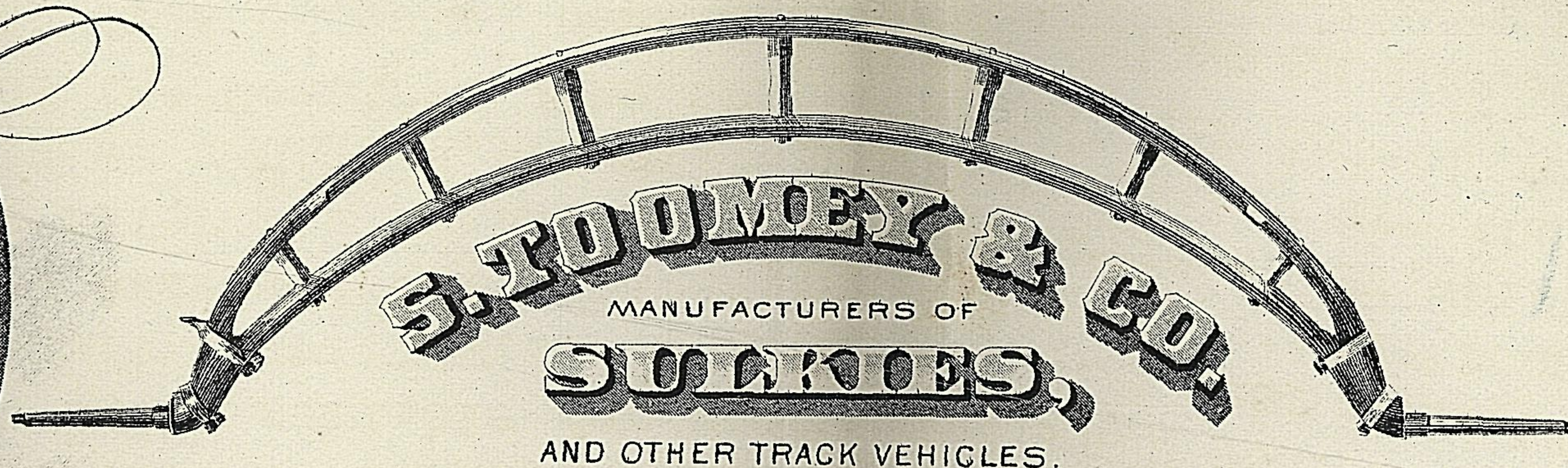
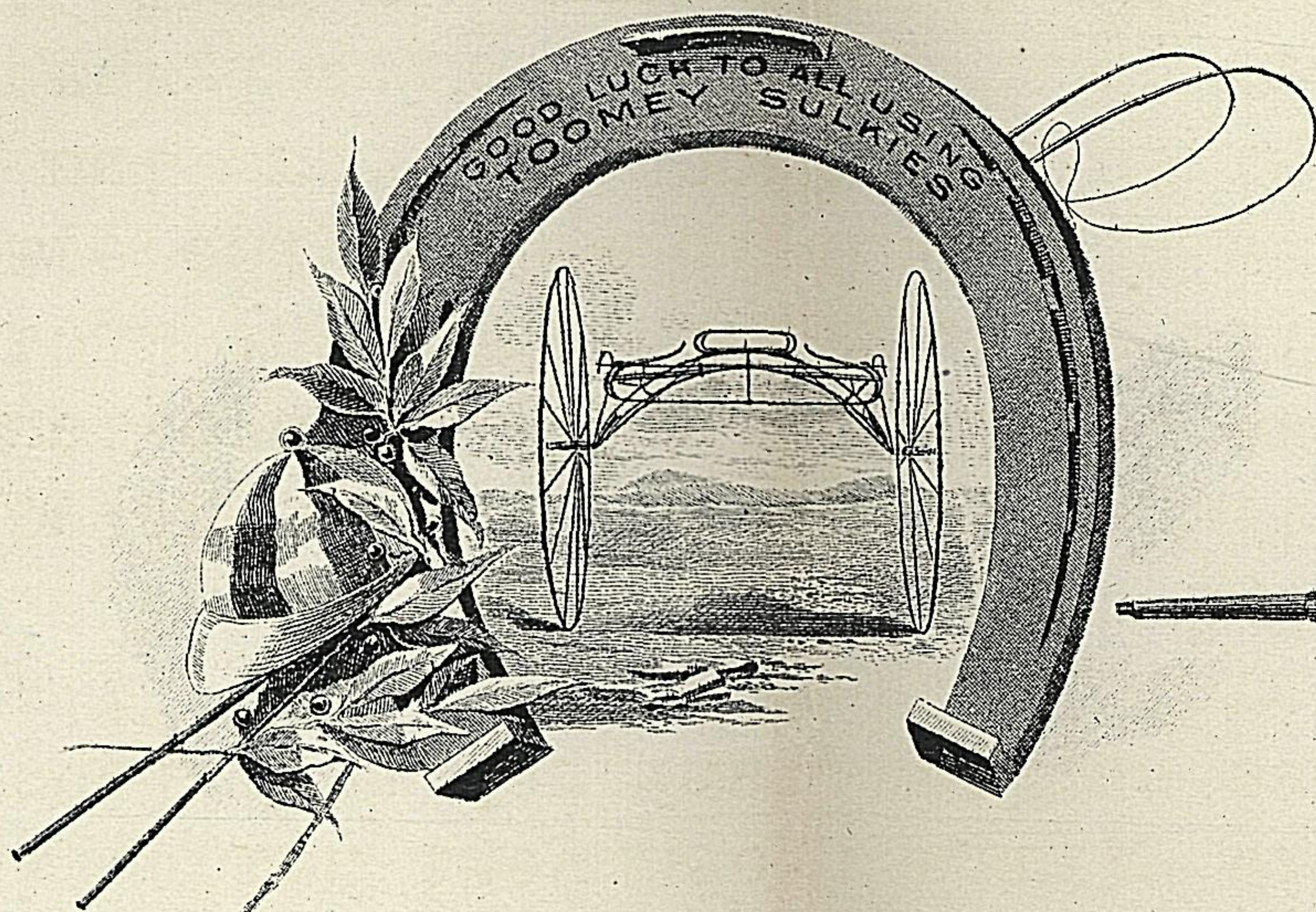




Canal Dover, O. March 19th, 1891/89

Dear Sir, We are in receipt of your favor of the 16th, stating that you desire a 45lb sulky for yearlings and 2 year olds, and note that you were very much pleased with the sulky that Mr. Marvin drove Palo Alto & Sunol to last Season.

Permit us to say, the sulky Mr. Marvin used was made several years ago, and we assure you that we are now building a better sulky than ever before. We are very much pleased to state, that the fastest records made the Past 5 years, have nearly all been made by horses while hooked to our Improved Truss Bar & Truss Axle sulkies. Sunol made her 2 & 3 year old record to this sulky; Stamboul 2:11 made his record to one; Guy 2:10 $\frac{1}{2}$ made his record to one of them; Cricket, 2:10 $\frac{1}{2}$ made his record to one; Hal Pointer, 2:09 $\frac{1}{2}$ in a race, made his record to one; Roy Wilks 2:08 $\frac{1}{2}$ done the trick in one; Nancy Halks (a 4 year old record) 2:12 $\frac{1}{2}$ was also hooked to a Truss Axle; Gold Leaf, 2:11 $\frac{1}{2}$ made her record in a Truss Axle sulky; "Freedom" (the great yearling record) 2:29 $\frac{1}{2}$ made his Phenomena mile in one of our latest improved Truss Axle sulkies, we only mention the above records to you to show you, that our improvements together with our superior constructed sulky, is conducive to the highest rate of speed; the Truss, is positively the stiffest and the only TRUE principle upon which a perfect, rigid running sulky can be made, and we assure you if "Happy Russel" would have been hooked to one of our Truss Bar & Truss Axle sulkies at the time he made his record of 2:21, his record to-day would have been 3 to 4 seconds faster.

We are now building sulkies for such horses as "Johnson", 2:06 $\frac{1}{2}$; Jack, 2:12; Allerton, 2:13; Thornless, 2:16 $\frac{1}{2}$; Delmarch, 2:18 $\frac{1}{2}$ and many other fast horses, who have always used other sulkies, and especially the Caffrey, but who find that other horses are making faster time in our sulky, which they necessarily will; and no other sulky has the essential qualities for fast work, as our improved Truss Bar & Truss Axle sulky, with our Patent diagonal formed shaft & co.

We can make you a 45lb sulky suitable for yearlings, 2 year olds and by an adjustment of the shaft carrier will do well on 3 year olds, if not over 15-3; as the Truss Axle affords greater hock and stifle room than any other sulky.
