

This DEED, made this twenty ninth
day of December, in the year Eighteen hundred
and eighty-four, by John B. Brown and Edwin
H. Brown, of Queen Anne's County, State of
Maryland, Trustees, Witnesses; whereas by
a Decree, of the Circuit Court, for Queen
Anne's County, in Equity, passed on the twenty
eighth day of April, in the year Eighteen hundred
and eighty three, in the case of "Charlotte Ann
Hyndow by Andrew Hyndson as her next friend
vs. Harriett Frances Murray and others," the
said John B. Brown and Edwin H. Brown were
appointed Trustees to sell the land decreed to
be sold, and have sold the same to Edward
Bromoy, of Queen Anne's County, aforesaid, at
and for the sum of seventeen hundred and four
dollars, and seventy cents, who has, fully paid
the purchase money therefor;
Now therefore in consideration of the Premises,
the said John B. Brown and Edwin H. Brown,
Trustees, do grant and convey unto the said
Edward Bromoy, his Heirs and assigns all
the right and title of all the parties to the
aforesaid cause in and to all that tract, part
of a tract or parcel of land sold to him, as
aforesaid, situate, lying, and being in Queen
Anne's County, aforesaid, in the Third Election
District thereof, in Spaniards Neck, adjoining
