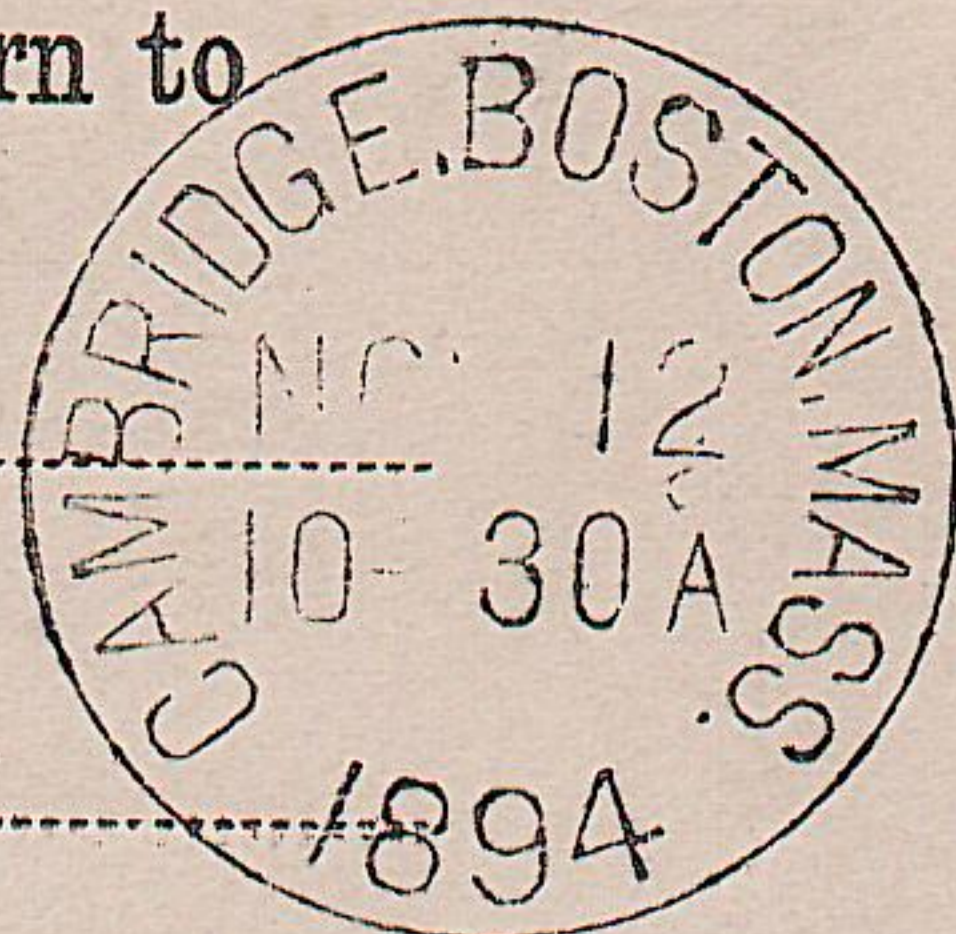


If not called for in days, return to
