Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 72; respiration, 17; temperature, n; height, 5 feet 8 inches; weight, 168 pounds; age, 46 years. General physical condition good. Scar of entrance of G.S.W. on right side 2 inches behind anterior superior iliac process of ilium. Scar is 1 1/2 inches long 1/2 inch wide. un-tilicated deeply depressed (1/2 inch) firmly adherent dragging. non sensitive. There is a watery oozing. From a minute sinus at bottom of depression Ball passed backward shattering the crest of ilium. Emerges 2 1/2 inches from humbo-sacral articulation and 6 inches from point of entrance. Scar of exit one inch long 3/8 wide depressed. adherent. dragging. non sensitive. Claims that several large pieces of bone came away. No other disability. This man's order cannot be found but as we have no doubt as to his identity - we examine him
