We hereby certify that in compliance with the requirements of the law we have carefully examined this applicant, who states that he is suffering from the following disability, incurred in the service, viz: Gun shot wound of Right Hip, resulting Affection of sides and Back and Wound discharging.

Here give the claimant's statement as briefly and as compactly as possible. He makes the following statement upon which he bases his claim for [Original, increase, restoration, &c.]
Claims to suffer with severe pains in the right hip as result of gun shot wound; much worse in damp weather.
Severe pain when stooping and is unable to lie on the right side. Cannot perform hard manual labor.

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 72; respiration, 18; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 8 inches; weight, 166 pounds; age, 50 years. General physical condition good.

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with Book of Instructions. Gun shot wound of right hip. Ball struck the right lateral aspect of the body just below the crest of the ilium two inches behind the anterior superior process. Scar is 1 1/2 inches long by 1/2 inch wide, umbilicated, deeply depressed not less than 1/2 inch, firmly adherent, nonsensitive. There is a minute opening of a sinus about the middle of the scar with thin watery discharge. The opening is too small to admit small probe. Ball passed directly backward shattering the crest of the ilium and emerged 2 1/2 inches from the lumbar-sacro articulation six inches from point of entrance. Scar of exit is one inch long by 3/8 inch wide, irregular, depressed, adherent, dragging, non-sensitive. He states that several large pieces of bone came away and that a piece of his canteen was removed from the wound. Sensitiveness along the track of the ball. Claims to have pain when stooping and on all motions of the body and when rising to the erect position. From the nature of the wound, we should judge that he suffers with severe pain as result. Heart, Lungs and abdominal organs normal. No other disability exists.
