No. 2. in claim No 921.659 of Dallis Brown, Edm of Minor Children of Geo Preston, Co. F. 30th M.S.C. and made oath in due form of law that I am a professional midwife.

And find from my Records in my possession that on the 12th day of March 1897, I attended Agnes Preston, the wife of George Preston, who gave birth on that date of a male child, who was named Daniel Preston. I also attended her on the 10th day of May 1902. When she gave birth to a female child. Known as Della Preston, the said wife had other children by the soldier. But I did not attend her during that time, I know of my own personal knowledge that the soldier acknowledge all the children as his by his wife Agnes Preston, I know all the children were placed in some institution. With the exception of Della, who is living this date and in the custody of Dallis Brown, who resides near my home, I further testify that the wife Agnes Preston, died before her husband did. And was buried at Mt Gilbert Cemetery, Idm, the first child died before her. I further testify that I have no interest in the claim. Witnessed by.
