Agnes Preston, there were no other children except those

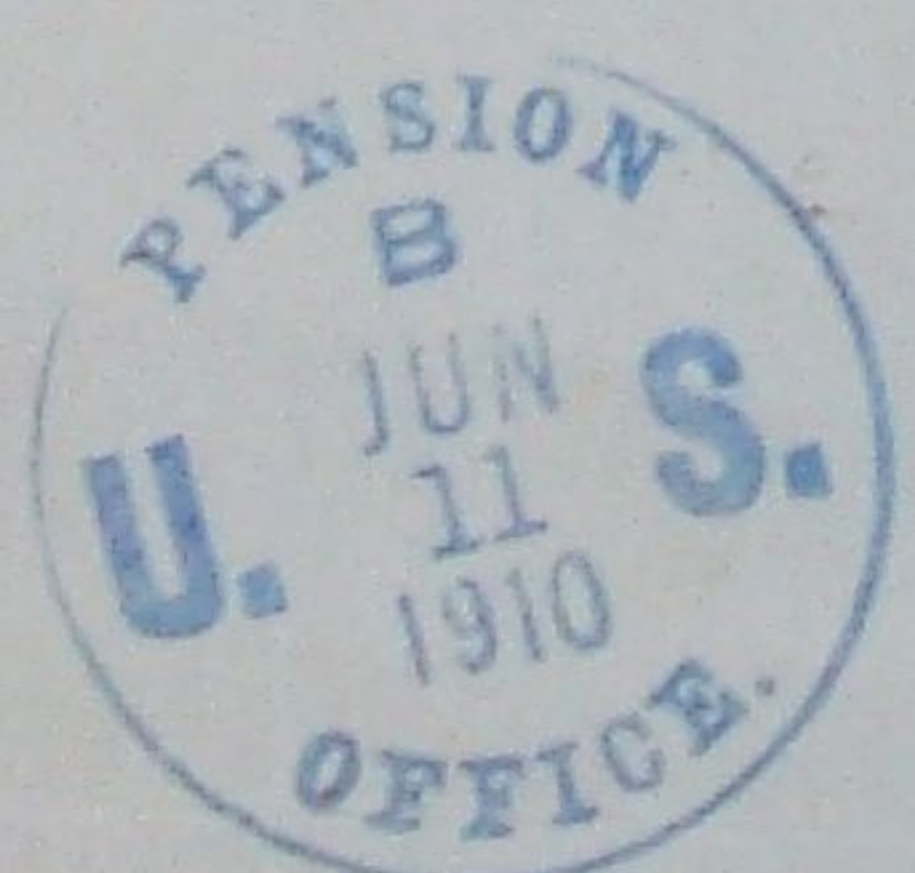
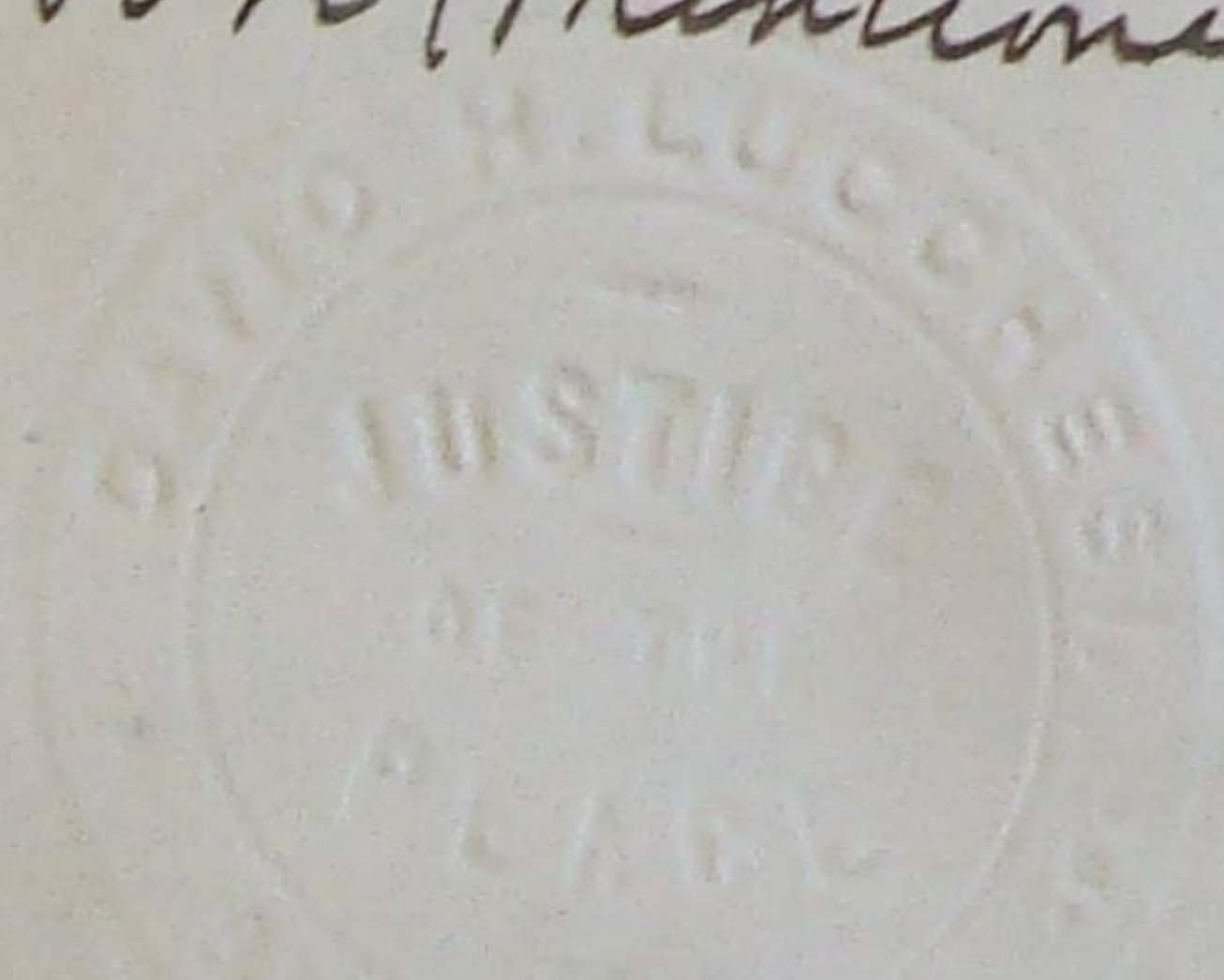
above mentioned. I further testify that I have no interest in the claim.
