State of Maryland City of Baltimore On this 3rd day of December A.D. 1886 before me a Justice of the Peace of the State & City aforesaid personally came Samuel Johnson late private Co (H) 39 Regiment U S C Troops living at no 445 Little Monument Baltimore City who having been duly sworn & says his Cause of applying for a Pension is from Rheumatism Contracted in the Army; that he was in front of Petersburg in or about the month of August in the Year 1864 was affected in his Spine & legs and some little in his arms, was still serving in the army and did not go to the Hospital until he was ordered to North Carolina about January 13/1885 at Fort Fisher - he was sent to the Hospital at Newbern (does not remember the name) North Carolina after the war where he remained in said Hospital about four months about June, he left the Hospital & returned to his Company - & then got sick again & was ordered to Hospital (the same one about September) and remained until the latter part of November 1885 - again went to his Company until he was discharged at Baltimore Fort Federal Hill. Has suffered ever since and is disabled from even doing a half mans work - & can only work at light work. Has been attended by Dr Jay - between Howard & Park Avenue Baltimore - Has lived in Baltimore since his discharge at up to the present time at the following places On Park Avenue near Saratoga & Clay lived there 3 years, went to no 47 - Little sharp street - went to live at Vine street between Colton & Schroeder and has there some two years and half - then on Hill street between Sharp & Howard has there two years - then on Jasper street no 79 - between Frank- lin & Druid Hill Avenue & has there about two years. Then went to his present abode no 445 Little Monument - & has been there not quite one year
