Enlisted in the fall of 1861³. Snow then was snow
on the ground the day after I enlisted.

Enlisted at Dukes Wharf, Calvert Co. Md. on
a Saturday. The next week I was sent to Camp
Belger. Baltimore City, Md. after my arrival
at camp Belger. I was examined by Dr. Augusta
and assigned to duty under Col. Bonniar
remained in Baltimore Md until about one
month after the surrender of Lee when I was
ordered to report to my regiment then
stationed on the Danville R.R. near Smithville
N.C. which I did. Cannot state the date of
my arrival at regimental head quarters.

Remained with my Company about one month
when I was taken sick with Diarrhoea, and
jaundice, and liver trouble, and sent to the
Hospital, at Raleigh, N.C. was there about two
months when I was sent to Hospital at
Newbern, N.C. when I remained until
about one month prior to the muster out of my
regiment. Was with my company the month
after muster out at Wilmington N.C.
Should have stated that I reported back to my
regiment from Raleigh N.C. and did duty
