

Did not see claimant after discharge until about 1884. & since then I have seen him more than a dozen times, and lately see him often.

Since 1884 each time I have seen claimant he has complained of rheumatism, and has been lame and used a stick.

Since 1884. If claimant had been as good a man as he was at enlistment or had been sound, he would at my work be worth \$2.50 per day. Now I rather than have him around with me would give him 30 cents to keep out of my way. He has in my opinion been totally disabled for any work since 1884.

Am not related to claimant, or interested in this claim for pension.
