

Declaration for the Increase of Pension and for New Disability under Act of June 27, 1890.

State of *Maryland*, County of *Baltimore* ss:

On this *2nd* day of *June*, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven
personally appeared before me, a *Justice of the Peace*
within and for the county and State aforesaid, *Samuel Johnson 72*, aged
years, a resident of the *539 Orchard Street*, County of *Baltimore*
State of *Maryland*, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner

of the United States, enrolled at the *Washington D.C.* Pension Agency, at the rate
of *Eight* dollars per month, Certificate No. *479399*, by reason of disability from
disability for which pension was granted. *"Rheumatism and heart disease"*

That he was a *Private* in Co. *"C"* *39th* *U.S. Troops*
