

DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

ACT OF JUNE 27, 1890.

To be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes in the State, city, or county where said officer resides. If such officer has a seal and uses it upon such paper, no certificate of a county clerk or prothonotary or a clerk of a court shall be necessary; but when no seal is used by the officer before whom the declaration is executed, then a clerk of a court of record or a county or city clerk shall affix his official seal thereto, and shall certify to the signature and official character of said officer.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, SS:
 On this 20th day of July, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety eight
 personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace
 within and for the county and State aforesaid, Susan Johnson
 aged 62 years, a resident of the 539 Orchard Street
 county of Baltimore, State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn
 according to law, declares that she is the widow of Samuel Johnson, who enlisted
 under the name of Samuel Johnson, at Baltimore, Md
 on the 28 day of June, A. D. 1864, in Private Co "C"
39th Regt. U.S.C. Troops
 Here state rank, company, and regiment, if in military service,
 or vessel, if in the Navy.

and served at least ninety days in the late War of the Rebellion, in the service of the United States, who was
 honorably discharged 4th December 1865, and died July 14, 1898
 The cause of death need not be stated.

That she was married under the name of Susan Waters to said
Samuel Johnson on the 15th day of Sept, 1852
 by Rev. Mr. Breemel, at Somerset Co. Md., there being no legal
 barrier to said marriage. no former marriage of claimant
or her husband
 If there was a former marriage of claimant or her husband, state it here and how dissolved.

That she has not remarried since the death of the said Samuel Johnson
 Name of soldier or sailor.

That she is without other means of support than her daily labor; that names and dates of birth of all the
 children now living under sixteen years of age of the soldier are as follows:

That her husband has not been employed in the Military or Naval service otherwise than as stated above, and
did not serve prior to 28 June 1864 or since 4 Dec. 1865

That she not heretofore applied for pension and the number of her former application is but deceased

That she makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States under
 the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890.

She hereby appoints with full power of substitution and revocation Geo. W. J. Turner

 State of Maryland, her true and lawful attorney to prosecute her claim and to receive therefor
