

Widow's Claim for Pension.

STATE OF Maryland COUNTY OF Baltimore S. S.

On this 23 day of July A.D. 1898, personally appeared before me the undersigned authority Florence Scott who, being duly sworn, makes this declaration in order to

obtain a Pension provided by the Act of Congress approved July 14, 1862. That she is the widow of Philip Scott, who was a member of Company B of the 30 Regiment of U. S. C. Inf. Vols. in the War of 1861: that she was married to said Soldier on or about the Second day of April 1890. She Further Declares that her said husband died on or about the Second day of July 1898, of disease contracted in the service.

She also declares that she has remained a widow ever since his death and that she has not in any manner been engaged in or aided or abetted the Rebellion in the United States. The following are the names and dates of birth of all the children of her deceased husband who were under sixteen years of age at the time of his death
