Sir:

In the above-entitled claim for pension, there should be furnished a full statement under oath of all services rendered in the army or navy by *above* named claimant.

If in the army, the full name of each organization in which service was rendered should be given, with the letter of the company and the number of the regiment, the names of commanding officers, and the dates and places of enlistment and discharge.

If in the navy, the dates and places of enlistment and discharge, and the names of all vessels on which *he* served should be stated.

The name of Philip Scott is not borne on the rolls of Co I 30 US Col Inf.
