Mary E. Richardson being first duly sworn states upon oath as follows: That she is the widow of the above named soldier and the applicant for his accrued pension; that her husband who died March 3-1915 was about 67 or 68 years of age; that at the time she got him in a sick benefit society she did not know his age and she gave his age as 46 years and he died about two years later; that her husband died at 722 N. Bruce Street, Baltimore, Maryland and Robert Elliott was his undertaker and Dr. McCarthy was his attending physician in his last illness, and soldier was buried in London Park, Balto., Md. That affiant's former husband Horace Lewis never was in the army, navy or Marine corps.

That affiant has no way to furnish the proof of death of Mary Eliza Larkin, former wife of the soldier and she asks the aid of the special examination division of the Pension Office if any further proof is needed as to any requirements in this case.
