I reside in Baltimore, Md., at No. 1522 Reggaw Street.

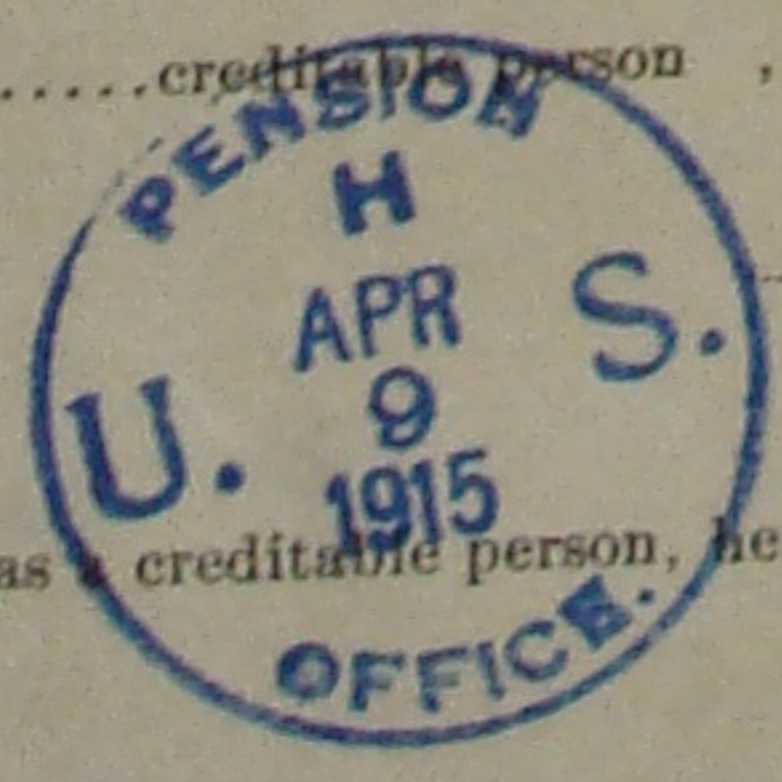
