and knee joints with pain complained of upon motion-no enlarge-
ment of joints-no atrophy or swelling of muscles-no contraction
or impaired motion-no lameness. All other joints and muscles
normal-no evidence of lumbago.DISEASE OF RECTUM AND PILES-Condition of rectum normal-no piles
DEAFNESS OF LEFT EAR-Can hear an ordinary conversation with
either ear at distance of six feet-auditory canal normal.DEFECTIVE VISION-Vision of either eye 20/20. Physical condition
of eyes normal.AFFECTION OF CHEST-Scar under lower border of pectoral muscle
of right chest 5 inches in length due to an injury when a childAFFECTION OF HEART-The heart is normal in size, position and
action-no dyspnoea, edema or cyanosis.

CATARRH-Condition of naso-pharynx normal.

LUNGS-Chest at rest 33 1/2-full inspiration 35 1/2-full expi-
ration 33. Percussion and auscultation reveal a normal condi-
tion of lungs and bronchi.KIDNEYS-Urine clear and amber color-specific gravity 1020-acid
reaction-no albumin, sugar or other abnormal deposits-tests-
heat, nitric acid and Fehlings.SENILE CHANGES-Arcus senilis-vessels stiff-no tremor-erect and
well nourished.
