

Supplemental Act of June 27, 1890.

DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

To be executed before a Court of Record or some officer thereof having custody of its seal, a Notary Public, or Justice of the Peace, whose official signature shall be verified by his official seal, and in case he has none, his signature and official character shall be certified by a Clerk of a Court of Record, or a City or County Clerk.

State of Md, City of Balt, ss:

On this 25 day of June, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety-
five, personally appeared before me, J. P.

William T. Richardson within and for the City and State aforesaid,
Joseph A. Nelson, aged 48 years, a resident of the city
of Balt County of Balt

State of Md who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is
the identical William T. Richardson, who was ENROLLED on the
day of August, 1864, in Co B 19th U.S.C.
(Here state rank, company, and regiment in Military service, or vessel, if in the Navy.)

in the service of the
United States in the war of the rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at
Balt Md, on the Feb day of 1866.

That he has never been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated
above.

(Here state what the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above, and the dates at which it began and ended.)
That he is unable to earn a support by manual labor by reason of Rheumatism
(Here name the disease or
Piles affection of back or kidneys, catarrh &
injuries from which disabled.)
disease of heart & chest

That said disabilities are not due to his
vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent. That he has heretofore
applied for pension under application No. 978 010. That he is a pensioner under Certificate No.

(If a pensioner, the Certificate number only need be given. If not, give the number of the former application, if one was made.)

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States, under
the provisions of the act of June 27, 1890.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation,

A. Parlett Lloyd of Baltimore, Maryland

his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim, the fee to be TEN DOLLARS as prescribed by law. That
