She was never divorced from him nor he from her.

I know this because if a divorce had been applied for or granted either of them I would have known it.

I have lived right here in Baltimore all the time and seen her often during all the time. They were not living together when he died.

He left her no property of any kind and she has had none since his death. She is a poor woman and has no income from any source except her own labor.
