

DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

Act of June 27, 1890.

Note.—This can be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes. If such officer uses a seal, certificate of clerk of court is not necessary, If no seal is used, then such certificate must be attached.

STATE OF Md COUNTY OF Balt ss:

On this 1 day of Augt, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety nine, personally appeared before me, a JUSTICE OF THE PEACE, within and for the City and State aforesaid Wm H Nelson, aged 52 years, a resident of the County Baltimore State of Md who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical

William H Nelson, who was ENROLLED on 11 day of Augt 1863 in Private Co B 1 U. S. I. Inf [Here state rank, company, and regiment if in the Army, vessel, if in the Navy.] in the service of the

United States in the war of the rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Washington, on the 4 day of May, 1866

That he is unable to earn a support by manual labor by reason of Disease of heart, heart, left side, affection (Here name the disease or injuries from which disabled.)

of back & kidneys, rheumatism & general debility

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief of a permanent character. That he has not applied for pension under application No. That he is a pensioner under Certificate No.

(If a pensioner, the Certificate number only need be given.)

If not, give the number of the former application, if one was made.)

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above.

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States, under the provisions of the act of June 27, 1890. He hereby appoints

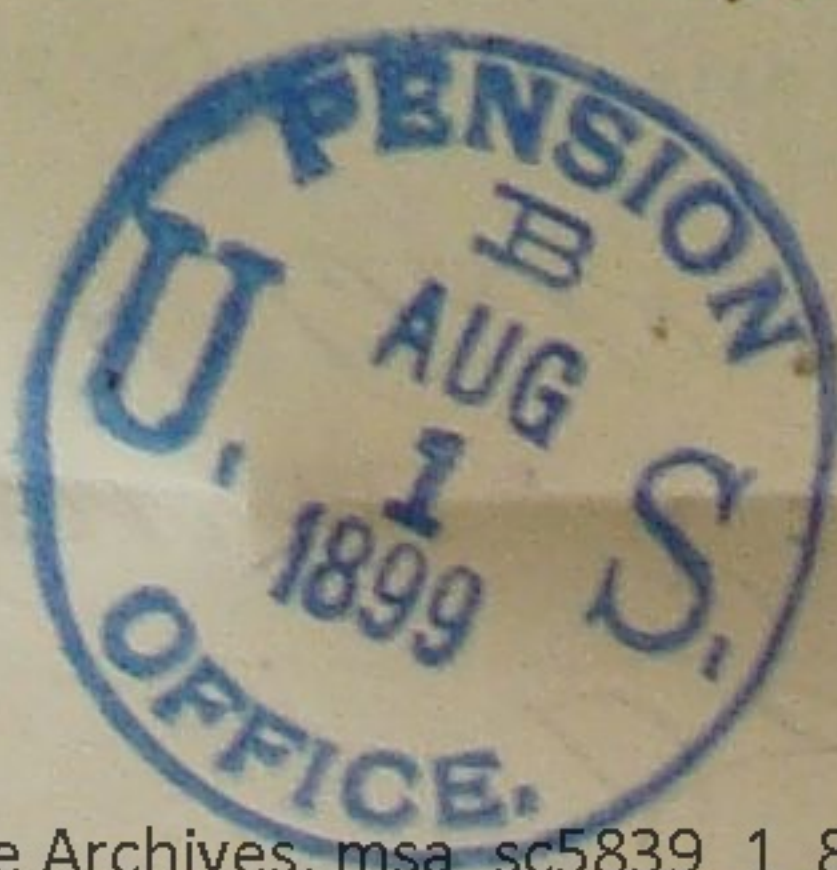
