My first husband's name was Solomon Norther. We were married just after the fall of Richmond by Elder - Thornton at Hampton Va. I was married to him under the name of Martha Wilson. He died in town here, about 10 or 12 years or more before I re-married to the soldier. I never was married to any other man nor did I live with any other, man up to the time I married the soldier. I was not married during slavery times.

My witnesses in my pension claim were Jane Reddick (my sister) Wm. Jarvis Nicholas White Sally Russell. They are about all I can recollect except Taylor Olmstead.

Mr - Frank now of Washn D.C. did some writing here for me and Carter Holmes also. I didn't pay Frank anything but I paid Holmes 25¢ for each paper he wrote for me and no more. James Turner was my attorney in Washn D.C. and the Gov't paid him for I didn't.

My pension certificate and vouchers are in my possession and I have never pledged either ^{deponent}.
