Sir:

In your claim for reimbursement in the case of Martha Rhodes, the pensioner above named, you should furnish from the proper officer of the "Tents Society", a statement showing, over his or her personal signature, whether the \$100 death benefit has yet been paid and to whom paid, or if not, why payment is being withheld.

From Mrs. Bessie Northern, a statement should be forwarded showing, over her signature, the length of time she paid premiums on the policy of insurance on the life of the pensioner in the Home Beneficial Insurance Company and whether she contributed any part of the insurance money she received toward the payment of the expenses of the pensioner's last sickness or burial, and if so, the amount and to whom paid.

The inclosed certificate should be signed by undertaker Jones.
