INSTRUCTIONS.

Under Order 229, of the Commissioner of Pensions, dated June 29, 1893, it is absolutely necessary in every case, where the witness does not write his own affidavit, that he shall close with, and embody in his affidavit, a statement, if it can be truthfully done, substantially as follows:

"And I (or we) further certify that the above statement was written by (here state the name of the person who writes affidavit) in my presence, and only from oral statements made to him on this (state the date) of (state the month), 189-, at (here state the name of the town or place where affidavit was written), and in making this above statement I (or we) did not use, and I (or we were) was not aided or prompted by any written or printed statement or recital prepared or dictated by any other person and not attached as an exhibit to this testimony."

If, however, the affiant writes the affidavit himself, he should close with, and embody in his affidavit, substantially the following words in his own handwriting:

"This affidavit is in my own handwriting, and I certify that in its preparation I was not aided or prompted by any written or printed statement or recital prepared or dictated by any other person."

Affidavits not made in strict conformity with these instructions will be rejected by the Pension Bureau.
This affidavit may be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths.

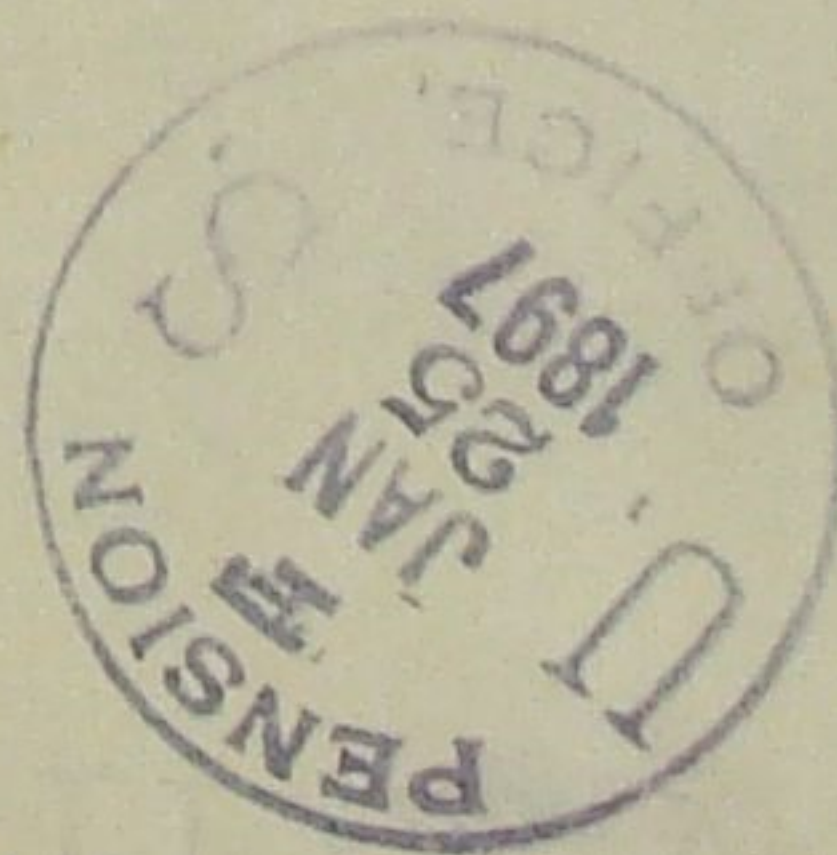
