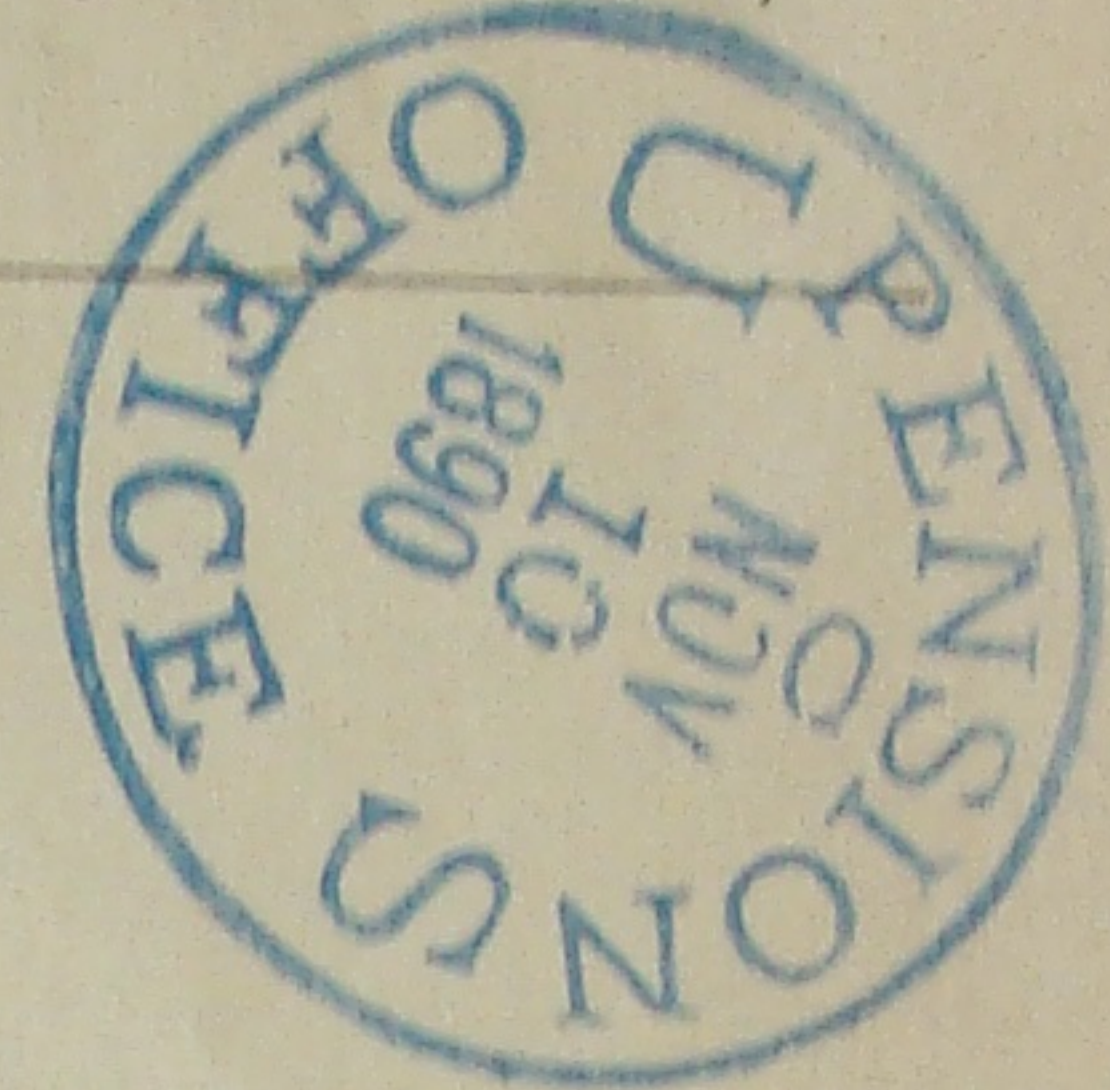

of the aforesaid, and that the children claimed for, viz:

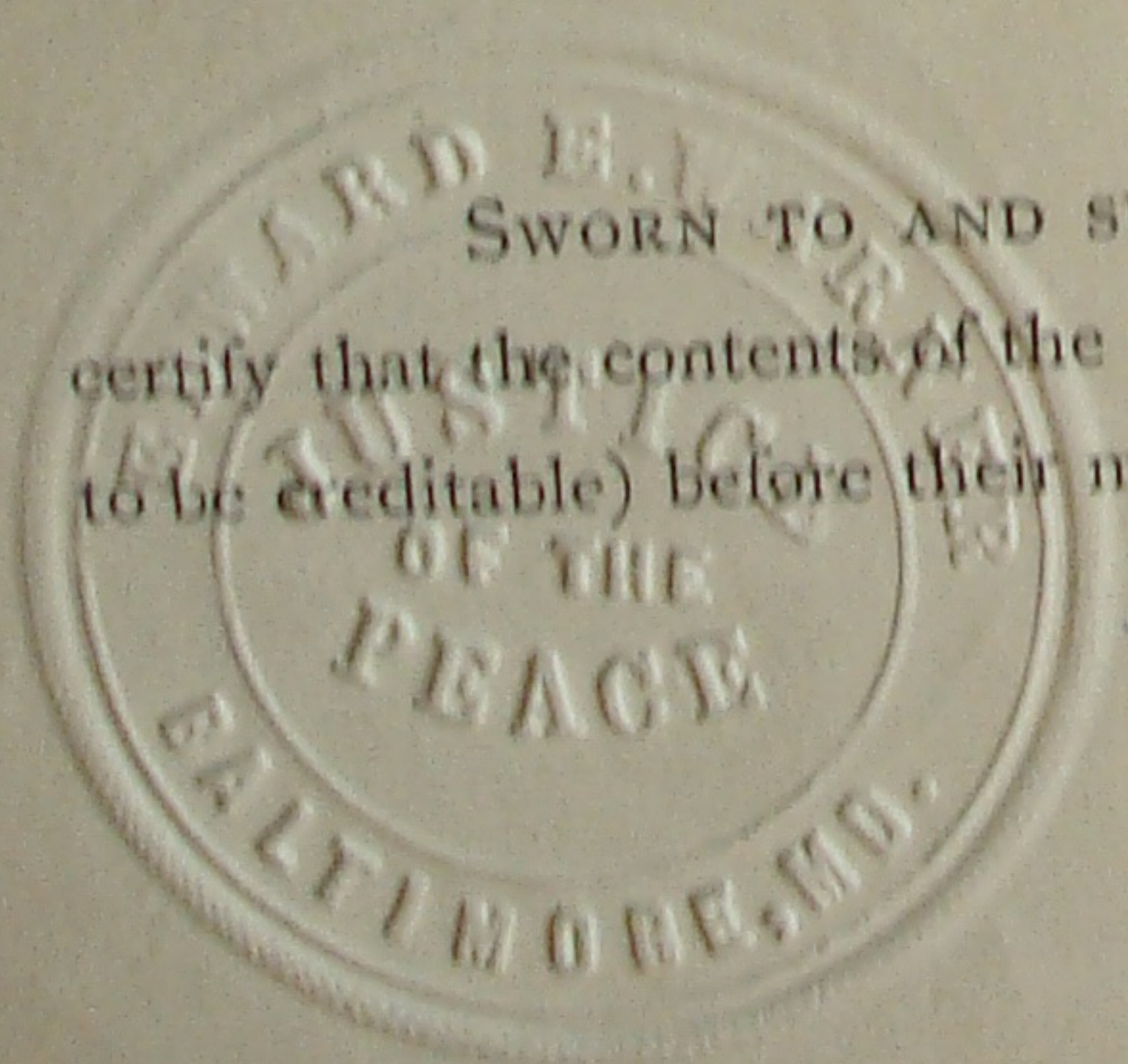
are still living under the care and maintainance of the claimant, and are personally
