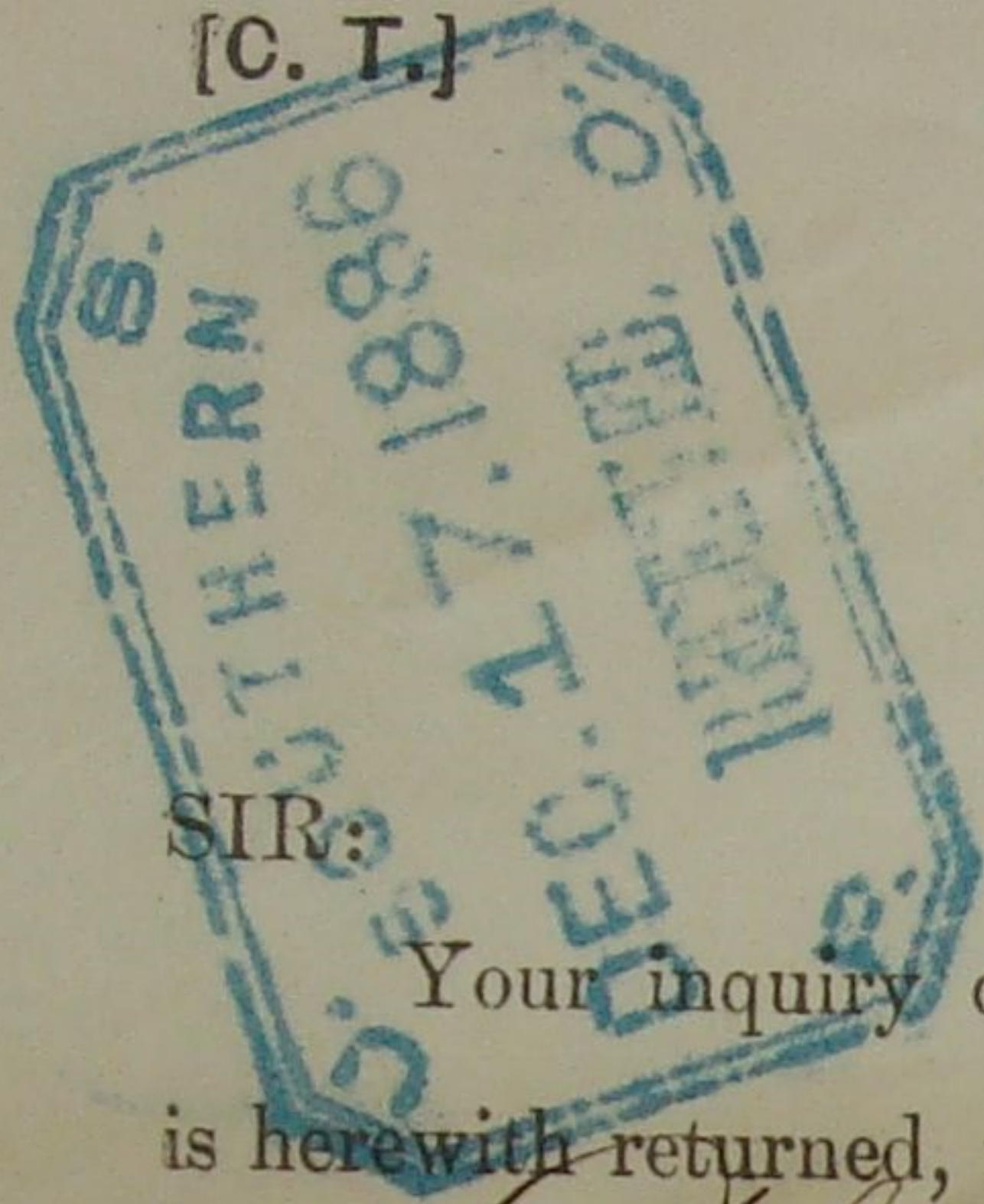

SIR:

Your inquiry of May 11, 1886, in Pension Claim No. 323,672, is herewith returned, with the following information:

Clement Potts was enrolled on the 15th day of July, 1863, at Baltimore Md., as a private in Co. C, 4th Regiment of U. S. Colored Troops, to serve 3 years.

He is reported on Muster Roll from Org. to June 30/64 present for duty: July & Aug. 64. present "detached as Co. Cook: Sept & Oct. and Nov & Dec 64 present for duty: Jan & Febr. 65 present "on duty as Co Cook: March & April 65 present for duty: May & June 65 present for duty, with remark: "Commutation due for rations from May 28. to June 25. 64; while absent with leave: July & Aug. 65 and to Febr. 28. 66 present for duty: March & Apr. 66. not on file. Regl. Return for March 66. (last on file) reports present "on daily duty as Co Cook."

He was mustered out of service with Co. May 4. 1866. at Washington D.C.

Regl. Returns for May and June 64 do not report him absent; May 65 reports him "absent Duty without leave."
