

DECLARATION OF A WIDOW FOR ACCRUAL PENSION.

State of Ohio
County of Adams

On this 19 day of Feb, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and 17
personally appeared before me, a Notary Public, within and for the county and
State aforesaid, Rebecca Ridout, aged 61 years,
a resident of Wamsley County of Adams,
State of Ohio, who being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration
in order to obtain the pension which had accrued to her husband, named below, at the time of his death.

That she is the widow of George Ridout
who served as a priv. in the B. L. Regt West Virginia
(State military organization or name of vessel.)
and who was a pensioner of the United States by certificate No. 624737, on the roll of the Pension
Agency at Columbus Ohio; that the last payment of his pension was made to
the 1st day of Dec, 1916; that he died on the 22 day of Jan, 1919

That she was married under the name of Rebecca Danning to said pensioner
at New Boston O on the 29 day of Aug, 1858
by Squire Walden J. P.; that there was no legal barrier to the marriage;
that she had been previously married; that the soldier had been previously married.

Frank Danning died Dec. 30, 1902 Nancy Ridout
widow of Wadsworth O.
(If there was a legal impediment to the marriage, the date and place of death or divorce of former husband or consort should be stated.)

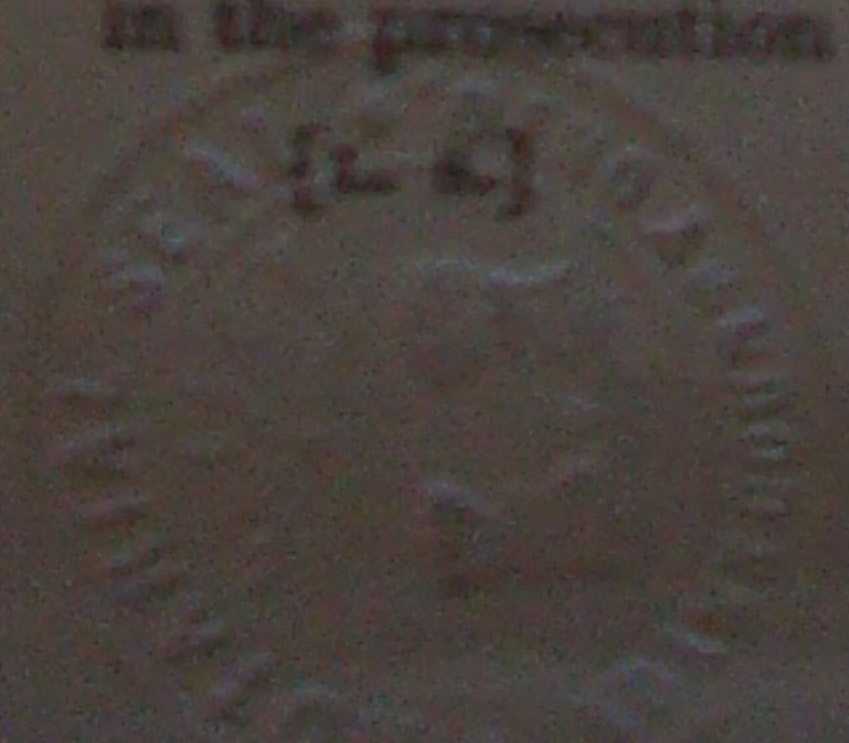
