DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

On this 20th day of February, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and seven, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and State aforesaid, George Ridout, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 75 years of age, and a resident of Scioto county of Scioto, State of Ohio; and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Parkersburg West Va under the name of George Ridout, on the 14th day of September, 1861, as a Private, in Company B^{2nd} Regiment West-Virginia Cavalry Volunteers (Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army, or vessels if in the Navy.) in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Wheeling West Va (State name of war, Civil or Mexican.) on the 29th day of November, 1864. That he also served no other service (Here give a complete statement of all other services, if any.)

That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That his personal description at enlistment was as follows: Height, 5 feet 10 inches; complexion, light; color of eyes, gray; color of hair, dark; that his occupation was laborer; that he was born November 7th, 1831, at Dorchester England.

That his several places of residence since leaving the service have been as follows: have not resided, in any other, than Scioto County. (State date of each change, as nearly as possible.)

That he is _____ a pensioner. That he has _____ heretofore applied for pension under Certificate No 602,737 at Columbus Ohio Pension Agency (If a pensioner, the certificate number only need be given. If not, give the number of the former application, if one was made.)

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of February 6, 1907.

That his post-office address is Scioto, county of Scioto, State of Ohio.
