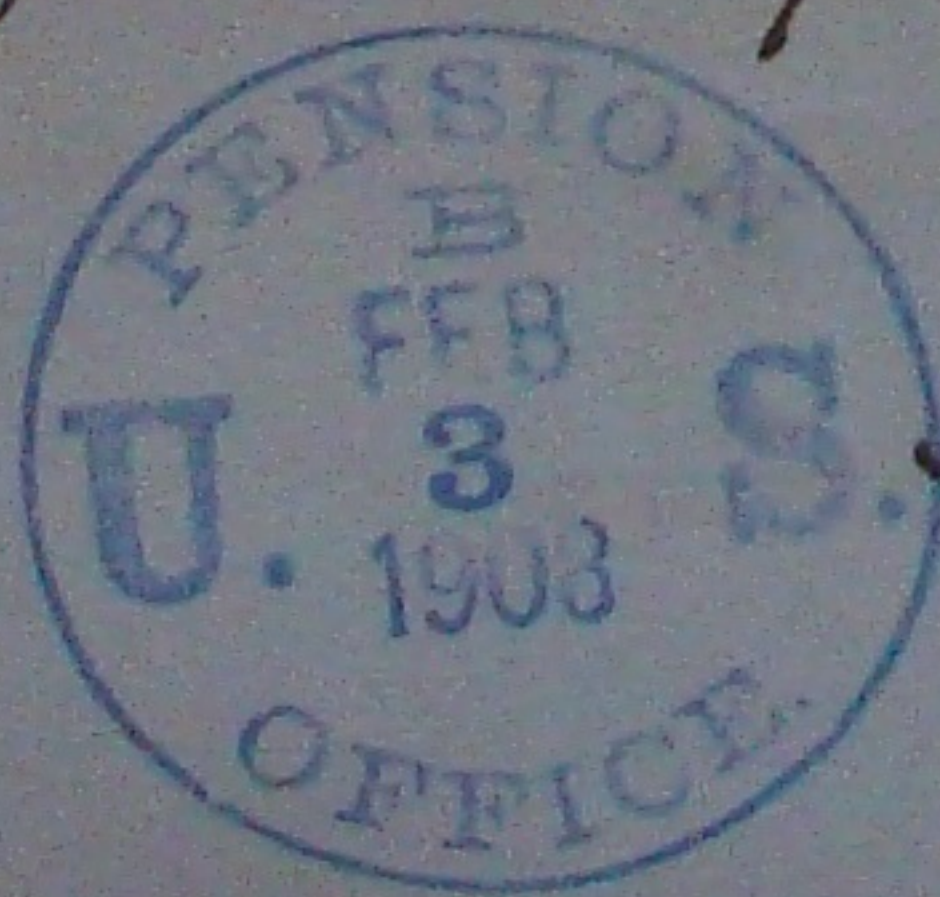


State of Ohio, County of Scioto ss

On this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of Jan 1908, personally  
appeared before me a Notary Public  
within and for the County and State aforesaid. Charles W.  
Hudson, of lawful age, a resident of town of  
Wheelburg County of Scioto, and State of Ohio,  
who being duly sworn according to law, declares  
in relation to the claim of George Ridout for  
pension, under the Act of Congress approved February  
6<sup>th</sup> 1907; that some time during the year 1902, he  
sold, and had erected in Church yard or Cemetery  
at Pine Creek, Scioto County Ohio, a Tomb Stone,  
upon which the following inscription was  
placed. to wit. Nancy Ridout born 1810. died  
1902; George Ridout, born 1832; affiant further  
says that Nancy Ridout was the wife of said George  
Ridout, who was a member of Co. 'B' 2<sup>nd</sup> West  
Virginia Vol Cavalry. war of the rebellion
