George Ridout, who, it is claimed, enlisted Sept. 20<sup>th</sup>, 1861, and served as private in Co. B, 2 Reg't W. Va Cav. ; also in Co.

Commanded by Capt J. B. Murdock

and was discharged at Wheeling W. Va, Nov. 29, 1864.

While serving in Co. B, 2 Reg't W. Va Cav, he was disabled by injury to left leg, received at Barboursville W. Va. Jan. 1862 and at Charleston W. Va. Winter of 1863 contracted cold resulting in Asthma and heart disease. and in Shenandoah Valley Va. Nov. 1864 received injury to head

and was treated in hospitals of which the names, location, and dates of treatment are as follows:
