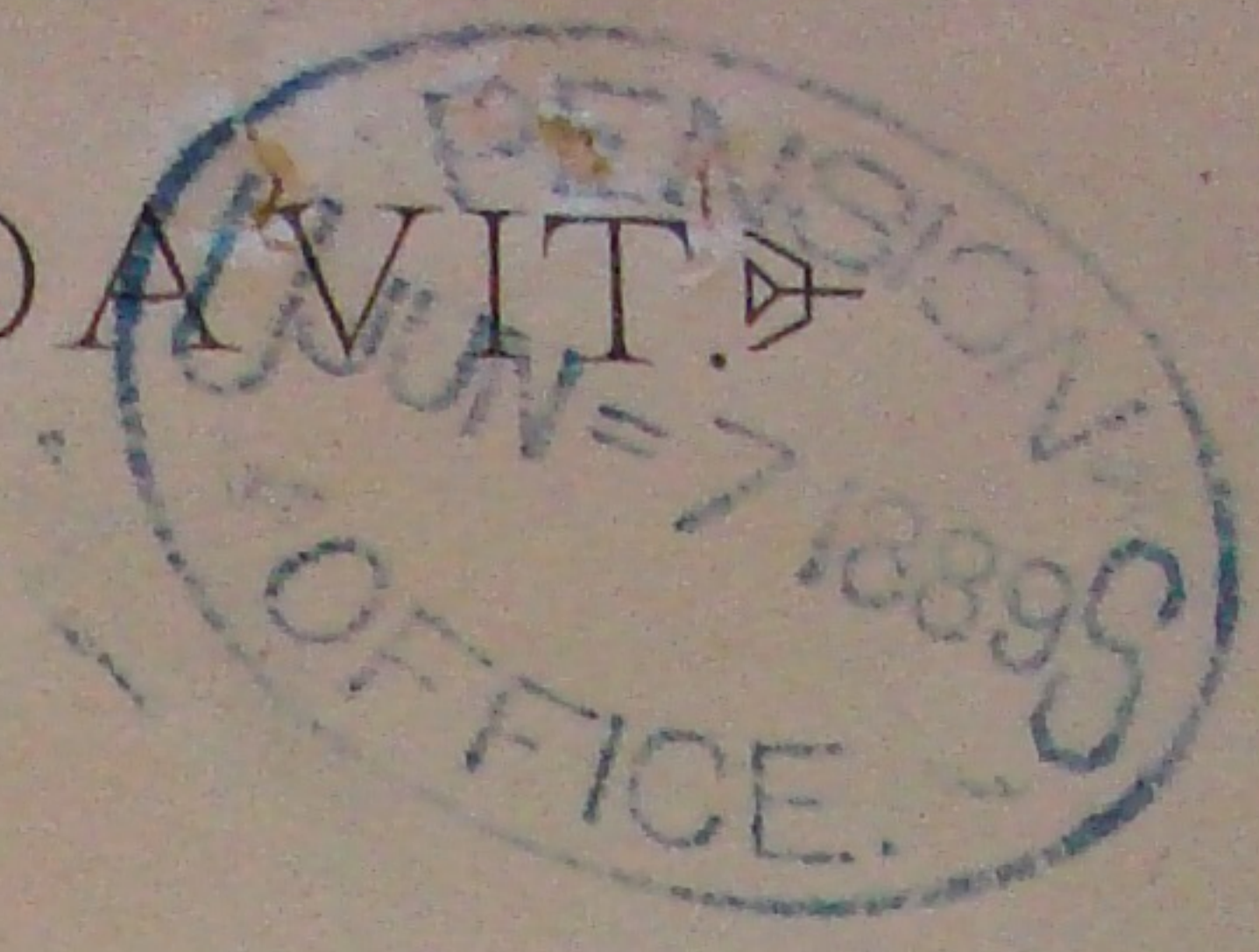


GENERAL AFFIDAVIT

In the matter of The Pension Claim No. 669,786 of George Ridant Late of Co B 2nd Regt W. Va Cav. Vols.

personally came before me, a Notary Public in and for aforesaid County and State, Samuel Clark aged 68 years, residing at Zronton Ohio well known to me to be reputable

and entitled to credit, who having been duly sworn, declares in relation to the aforesaid case as follows: I was late a member of Co B 2nd Regt W. Va Cav. Vols and I am well and personally acquainted with the above named claimant and know that near Barboursville W. Va on or about Jan 1862 he received an injury to his left leg by his horse falling on him. That while at Charleston W. Va in the latter part of the winter of 1863 he contracted severe cold which afterwards resulted in Asthma & heart trouble. While in the Shanadoah Valley about 1st of November 1864 he received an injury to his head while skirmishing on horse back by coming in contact with a fence stake. Claimant complained of said troubles and injuries while in the service up to the date of our discharge. I know said claimant was treated in the hospital at Charleston W. Va. and Cumberland Md for said troubles to wit Asthma & heart trouble and injury to head.
