Horace Neal was enrolled on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of March, 1864, at Howard, Md., as a Private in Co. G, 39<sup>th</sup> Regiment of U. S. Colored Troops, to serve 3 years.

He is reported on Muster Roll from Orgn. to April 30. 64, present for duty:  
May & June "Killed while on fatigue duty before Peters-  
burg Va. June 25. 1864", and so accounted for in Muster  
out Roll of Co. dated Dec. 4. 65.
