

DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

ACT OF JUNE 27, 1890.

To be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes in the State, city, or county where said officer resides. If such officer has a seal and uses it upon such paper, no certificate of a county clerk or prothonotary or a clerk of a court shall be necessary; but when no seal is used by the officer before whom the declaration is executed, then a clerk of a court of record or a county or city clerk shall affix his official seal thereto, and shall certify to the signature and official character of said officer.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, SS:
On this 15 day of December, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety four

personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace,
within and for the county and State aforesaid, Catherine Jason
aged 66 years, a resident of the 118 Writers Ave, Catonsville,
county of Baltimore, State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn

according to law, declares that she is the widow of Archibald Jason, who enlisted
under the name of Archibald Jason, at
on the 31 day of August, A. D. 1864, in Sergeant Co. "G" 29 Regt.
U.S. Troops and Co. E. 28 U.S. Troops
or vessel, if in the Navy.

and served at least ninety days in the late War of the Rebellion, in the service of the United States, who was
honorably discharged 6 November 1865, and died 26 November 1904
The cause of death need not be stated.

That she was married under the name of Catherine Nelson to said
Archibald Jason on the 18th day of November, 1862,
by Rev. Mr. Hanks, at Lisbon, Howard Co., Md, there being no legal
barrier to said marriage. no former marriage by claimant
If there was a former marriage of claimant or her husband, state it here and how dissolved.

That she has not remarried since the death of the said Archibald Jason
Name of soldier or sailor.

That she is without other means of support than her daily labor; that names and dates of birth of all the
children now living under sixteen years of age of the soldier are as follows:

That her husband has not been employed in the Military or Naval service otherwise than as stated above.
did not serve prior to 31 Aug. 1864 nor since 6 Nov. 1865

That she has not heretofore applied for pension and the number of her former application is but deceased

That she makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States under
the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890.

She hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation
