

DECLARATION FOR INCREASE OF PENSION AND NEW DISABILITY
Under Acts of June 27, 1890, May 9, 1900, and Order of March 15, 1904.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

ON THIS 26 day of May, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and four

personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace
within and for the County and State aforesaid, Archibald Jason, aged 75
years, a resident of the Batonsville County of Baltimore

State of Maryland, who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner
of the United States enrolled at the Washington, D.C. Pension Agency, at the rate
of Eight dollars per month, Certificate No. 764060, by reason of disability from Dyspepsia

That he was a Sergeant in Co. G, 29th Regt. U.S. C. Troops Vols.
Company and regiment of service if in the Army, or vessel and rank, if in the Navy.
having enlisted on 31st August 1864 and honorably discharged on
6th November 1865

That he has not been employed in the Military or Naval service otherwise than as stated above.

That he did not serve prior to 31st Aug. 1864 nor since 6th November 1865

That he believes himself to be entitled to an increase of pension on account of Increased

And he also believes himself to be entitled to a further increase of pension on account of the following
disabilities for which he has not heretofore been pensioned. Disease of Heart
and eyes If either of these new disabilities are the result of an injury,

Also by reason of infirmities of age, being born on the 13th day of March, 1829
applies for a rating under order of Commissioner of March 15, 1904

That said disabilities are not the result of his vicious habits and are to the best of his knowledge
