

Declaration for the Increase of Pension and for New Disability under Act of June 27, 1890.

State of *Maryland*, County of *Baltimore* ss:

On this *24* day of *January*, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety *three* personally appeared before me, a

JUSTICE OF THE PEACE

within and for the county and State aforesaid, *Archibald Jason*, aged *65* years, a resident of the *Catonsville* county of *Baltimore*

State of *Maryland*, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the United States, enrolled at the *Washington D.C.* Pension Agency, at the rate of *Six* dollars per month, Certificate No. *764060*, by reason of disability from

Dyspepsia and Rheumatism Here name the disability for which pension was granted

That he was a *Sergeant* in Co. *"G" 29* Regt. *U.S. Vols.* Here state rank, company, and regiment if in Army—vessel, if in Navy.

That he believes himself to be entitled to an increase of pension on account of *Increased Disability from Dyspepsia and Rheumatism* Here state the reason for applying for increase. If on account of increase in the disability for which already pensioned, that should be described.

And he also believes himself to be entitled to a further increase of pension on account of the following disabilities for which he has not heretofore been pensioned. *viz: Chronic Diarrhoea and Disease of Eyes (Conjunctivites)* Whether of these new disabilities are result of an injury or accident, state where, when, and how they were incurred.

That said disabilities are not the results of his vicious habits and are to the best of his knowledge permanent in character; that he appoints *Geo. W. H. Vernon* of *108 St. Paul St. Baltimore*, County of *Baltimore*, State of *Maryland* his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim. That his P. O. address is *Catonsville*, County of *Baltimore*, State of *Maryland*
