



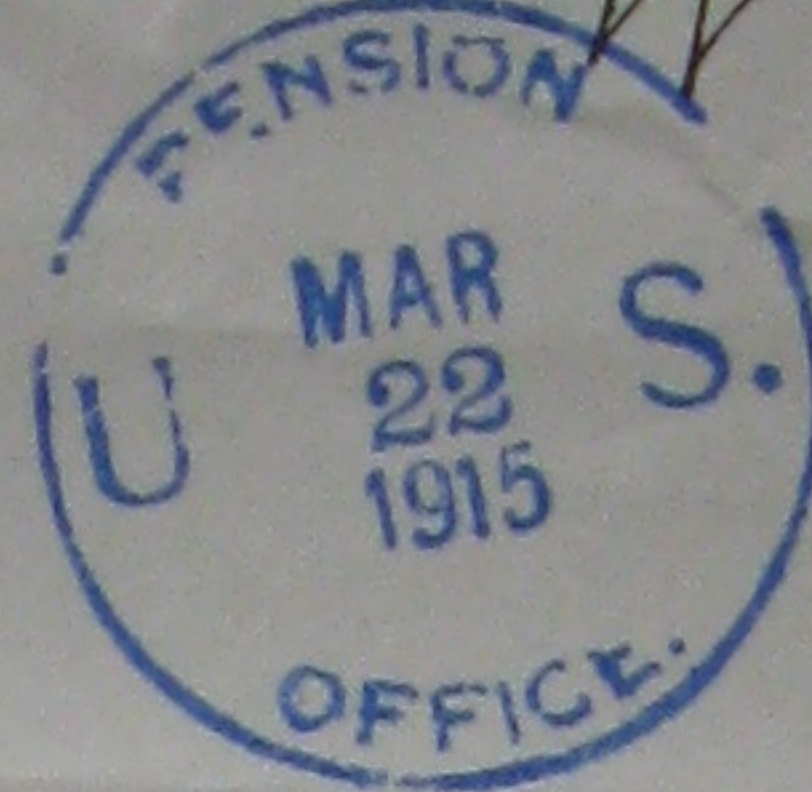

- No. 2. What was your post office at enlistment? Answer. *Ellicott City Ind.*
- No. 3. State your wife's full name and her maiden name. Answer. *Mary J. Stewart (maiden) Mary J. Robinson*
- No. 4. When, where, and by whom were you married? Answer. *May 18th Carroll Manor, by Rev. Father Griffin in Howard Co. Ind.*
- No. 5. Is there any official or church record of your marriage? Answer. *Yes.*
If so, where? Answer. *Court House, at Ellicott City Howard Co. Ind.*
- No. 6. Were you previously married? If so, state the name of your former wife, the date of the marriage, and the date and place of her death or divorce. If there was more than one previous marriage, let your answer include all former wives. Answer. *No.*
- No. 7.
