### INSTRUCTIONS AS TO EXECUTION OF APPLICATION.

This application must be executed before some officer of a court of record having custody of its seal, a notary public, justice of the peace, or other officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes. If such officer is not required by law to have and use a seal, his official character, signature, and term of office must be certified by the proper State, county, or city officer, under his official seal, unless such certificate has been filed in the Bureau of Pensions for general reference.  
A blank space is left at the close of applicant's affidavit that the time, place, and manner of the loss or destruction of the pension certificate may be set forth. In case of loss of certificate, it should be shown that proper efforts have been made for its recovery.  
The pensioner's oath must be supported by the evidence of another person as to identity. The witness must swear that he or she well knows applicant to be the same person described in his or her affidavit, and the magistrate must certify that the affiants are persons of veracity.
