

DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

Act of June 27, 1890.

States Colored Troops for three years.

and served at least ninety days in the late war of the Rebellion, who was HONORABLY DISCHARGED on 4th day of December 1865 and died on the 11th day of Feb 1891 at Hoboken, New Jersey

(The cause of death need not be stated.)

That she was married under the name of Mannie Christie, to said

Deatus Dorsey, on the 1st day of January

1864, by C. C. Beebe, at Baltimore, Maryland

there being no legal barrier to such marriage. Neither the said claimant nor her

said husband the said Dorsey had been previously married.

That she has not remarried since the death of the said Deatus Dorsey
