On my return from the Army the latter

year till 1866. then went to Mr Hammond Dorsey's
about 7 miles from Ellicott's City, Md. remained
about 2 years till 1868. then went on the adjoining
farm. R. F. Dorsey's remained till 1872
removed from there to Baltimore Co. "Carroll P. O."
My present residence
My Occupation has been
that of driving and light work about the farms.
As to my disability, whilst in line of duty near
Petersburg Va. about June 1864. was ruptured
on the right side by a heavy log falling upon
me whilst engaged in putting up breast works
was treated by Dr. Jacob R. West Regt. Surgeon
was under his treatment for about 3 months
who also gave me a truss to wear. and informed
me that nothing else could be done for me
I have had no medical treatment since my
discharge. I have been unable to work more
than one half of my time since my discharge
on account of said disability
