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person, of lawful age, who, being duly sworn, declare in relation to the aforesaid claim, as follows:

I have been well acquainted with Gen Jones the claimant, since 1860 worked with him on a farm about that time (1860) and knew him only as a sound, healthy able-bodied man working steadily every day. Claimant lived with me in the same house, shortly after his discharge from the army, and saw him every day and he started to work with me but was obliged to quit work on account of being retarded and having the piles very badly of which he constantly complained, stayed at the house for about three years and during this time has had had considerable medical treatment and was laid up in bed off and on for weeks and sometimes much longer periods. Always said that the rupture and piles were due from service. He is totally unable to, and does not perform any manual labor on acct of the rupture and piles. Lived with me for 3 yrs after discharge, after leaving my father's house I have seen him on an average of three or four times a week and consider him a broken down man, his disabilities disabling him more and more each year since discharge.

He further declare that he has no interest in said claim, and is not concerned in its prosecution.
